The Center for a Stateless Society (C4SS) is a market anarchist media center.

C4SS is a project of the Molinari Institute, an Alabama non-profit corporation. The mission of the Molinari Institute is to promote understanding of the philosophy of Market Anarchism as a sane, consensual alternative to the hypertrophic violence of the State.

The Institute takes its name from Gustave de Molinari (1819-1912), originator of the theory of Market Anarchism.

What do we do?

C4SS develops and publishes a variety of market anarchist propaganda -- including timely written commentary, research pieces, short audio and videos.

We've also recently started offering a series of online courses in Anarchist Theory and Practice in the belief that a broad base of well informed advocates are perhaps the most important media channel.

Why does this matter?

C4SS explicitly offers a bold vision of a completely free society and uncompromising critiques of the status quo. We believe this has the capacity to inspire people to take action. Even among those who don't fully subscribe to our vision, we push the boundaries of acceptable discourse. As has been said before, if one wants reform, aim for revolution.

What is Market Anarchism?

Market Anarchism is the doctrine that the legislative, adjudicative, and protective functions unjustly and inefficiently monopolised by the coercive State should be entirely turned over to the voluntary, consensual forces of market society.

The first explicit defender of Market Anarchism was the 19th-century economist and social theorist Gustave de Molinari.

The idea was taken up by the individualist anarchists, particularly those associated with Benjamin Tucker's journal *Liberty*. More recently, Market Anarchism has been revived by a number of thinkers in the libertarian movement.

The terms "anarcho-capitalism" and "voluntary socialism" have both been associated with the Market Anarchist tradition.
